

Aim

This course will cover the principles of supply chain resilience, highlighting the importance of an integrated risk and resilience approach across the organisation. Supply chain resilience is the the ability of an organisation to effectively respond to, recover and learn from disruptions to its supply chain. This course will provide worked through examples and real life case studies of supply chain disruptions across various industries. At a time when organisations are more global and interconnected than ever and experiencing significant disruptions to operations, a focus on supply chain risk and resilience management is more significant than ever.

Course Overview

This course will be split into four 90 minute modules with a mix of theory, practical examples and activities;



Learning Outcomes

This course will help you to:

- 1  Understand the importance of an integrated risk and resilience management approach to the supply chain.
- 2  Explore the effect of global risks and challenges to the supply chain.
- 3  Apply supply chain resilience strategies and processes to improve an organisation's ability to respond and recover to disruptions efficiently.
- 4  Look at real life case studies and examples of supply chain incidents and responses.

Who this course is for?

This is a broad based approach to supply chain resilience, to provide a baseline knowledge across your organisation from board level to middle management.

Duration and format

This is a one day course including;

- Six hours of recorded training material, split into four 1.5 hour modules
- Trainee handbook and activity book
- Four practical activities at the end of each module
- An end of course assessment.
